* A discussion was held about the Lake Erie Tournament and the weights and methods used. Along with the Classic and the July 12th Tournament at Chautauqua.

* Concerns were addressed about the following events that took place at the season opener; Release of the fish was a critical problem, people were scrambling around the dock tiring to save fish that should have been released out in the lake or deeper water, this was addressed several times and has been a reoccurring issue. All members are reminded that deep water fish are to be released back out in the lake. We have to remember that we do not any bad publicity to follow any of our events and our main concern is the safe release of the fish we catch. Huge thanks go out to all members who worked to insure that the fish were fizzed and returned to the water safely and to the members who released their fish back out in the lake.

* The Tournament committee will address the DEAD fish at the scale and their ruling will be final, Concerns about the first weigh in were addressed and should be resolved at the next event. 1 Person will be calling the weights, 1 will be weighing the fish along with measuring them and 1 will be keeping track of the weights.

* Concerns about Non-Boaters being back boated were tabled; all members are reminded that Non-Boaters should be given a fair chance to fish any and all waters. If you draw a Non-Boater then remember that they should be given a fair chance to fish the same water as you.

* Once again concerns were raised about the launching and retrieval of the boats both before and after an event. Both Boaters and Non-boaters are reminded that we all need to work together to get all the boats in and out of the water in a timely manner. If you are a Non-Boater and you have the ability to back a truck you are reminded to give a helping hand. If everyone hands their keys to the next person the retrieval process will be expedited.

* All members are reminded that the Tournament Committee members should be the first people out of the water to allow for set up of the weigh in materials.
