Scott Gauld led a discussion on the topic of fizzing fish. Fish care is extremely important. Make sure you give your fish every chance to survive. Dead and or floating fish gives tournament fishing and our club bad publicity.
Patrick Schlosser talked to Officer Rice from the US Border Patrol, Marine Division at the Buffalo NY office on 5/26/15.

Officer Rice stated that "We are taking the stand that you DO NOT need to call US Border Patrol when you return from fishing Canadian water as long as you do not make landfall. We understand that Canadian Border Patrol is requiring anglers to report in before fishing Canadian water. We are not requiring you to report back to US Border Patrol as long as you do not make landfall in Canada."

- It is the anglers responsibility to know all Canadian fishing regulations.

TOURNAMENT UPDATE

- First tournament of the 2015 season is June 20th from 6:00am-2:00pm on Lake Erie. The draw for the tournament is

- To enter the tournament you must either be at the draw, have someone at the draw enter you and pay for you or contact Patrick Schlosser with your prepaid tournament coupon number

no later than 5:00pm the day of the draw. (sooner the better). Messages may not be left!

- All live fish at the Lake Erie tournament MUST be released outside the marina and the no wake zone!
- It is the responsibility of the angler to take and dispose of their non-surviving fish.
- It is everyone's responsibility to help all anglers get their boats off the water.
- Every member should know all of the WNY Bassmaster rules and regulations. (current rules are on the clubs website.)

Rule #2 under Disqualification & Penalties: Culling a dead fish from your livewell for any reason

Rule #4 under <u>Disqualification & Penalties:</u> Failure to wear a securely fastened PFD whenever the large combustion engine is operating.

Rule #8 under <u>Disqualification & Penalties</u>: The use of any electronic communication device with the intent to send or receive fishing

related information. (Put the cell phones away. Except for emergencies)
